

## REOPENING SOME STUDENT AND CHILDREN'S SUNDAY MORNING PROGRAMS

Dear WHBC Families:

As we look forward to Phase 2.5 and the reopening of a portion of our Student and Children's Programs, we want you to know that we are working diligently and prayerfully to provide a safe environment for your children to come back to church with their peers, learning and growing through the teaching of God's Word. **Beginning August 9, at 10:30a, one hour of programming will be provided for infants through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.** We do not make these decisions lightly: Our desire is to bring our WHBC families back together in worship at WHBC. Yes, it will feel and look different, but that's ok. God is still the same God, and we will continue to grow and be more like Him.

### **JAM City Kids** (*infants-6<sup>th</sup> grade*)

#### **Where do I drop off my children?**

- The Check-In area will now be in the foyer by the Children's Area doors. Please form a single line in the designated area. THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE CHILDREN'S AREA FROM THE FRONT PARKING LOT.
- Check-in will begin at 10:15a.
- We ask that only one parent stand in the line to check-in their children.
- Only workers and children will be able to enter into JAM City.
- During the check-in process your child's temperature will be taken and hands sanitized. Temperatures will be taken using a contactless forehead thermal scanner. If any child registers at 100.4 degrees or above they (and their siblings) will not be able to attend JAM City programs.

#### **How do I pick up my children?**

- Please wait in line in the designated area by the Check-In desk (located in the foyer).
- We ask that only one parent stand in the line to pick up their children.
- Children will be brought to you.

### **New Heights Youth** (*7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade*)

- Teens will meet in the youth room with Pastor Josh Tuttle, at 10:30a.
- This will replace their current Sunday evening meetings.
- Chairs will be set up for social distancing.
- Students will exit the Youth Room using the back stairwell to the stage area behind the Activity Center (gym).
- Parents, meet your students in the back parking lot after the 10:30a service (approximately 11:45a).

### **What precautions will be taken?**

#### **Masks**

- Teachers and volunteers will be wearing masks unless they are able to maintain social distance (6 ft. from students).
- JAM City children are not required to wear masks, but families should make a choice that is best for them.

#### **Supplies**

- Each JAM City child (PreSchool thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade) will have their own school box, with supplies most commonly used. Children will not be sharing these supplies. High traffic surfaces will be wiped down frequently.

#### **August Schedule**

- Nursery – Two rooms will be available.
- Preschool thru 4th grade will continue to work their way through the Gospel Project, in the following groups.
  - Preschool (*in their own room*)
  - PreK (*in their own room*)
  - Kindergarten (*in their own room*)
  - 1st-4th (*Central Park, social distance style*)
- 5-6th grade will have their Bible Study with John Burkard (*in their own room*)
- Snacks & water will not be provided during the month of August.

### **What if our family can't attend?**

- The Gospel Project curriculum and short video (support video from Gospel Project) will continue to be available each week on our website.
- We hope to offer a video of the live story lesson taught by the JAM City teacher, at some point after each Sunday. Be patient with us as we work through our options to see what may work best.
