1. Christ is still dead (15:12-13)
2. Paul's message and their faith are empty (15:14)
3. Paul is a false witness (15:15)
4. Believers are still unsaved (15:16-19)

B. If there is a resurrection, then . . .

1. Christ will raise the dead (15:20-24)
2. Christ will destroy the power of death (15:25-26)
3. Christ will be the ruler of all things (15:27-28)
