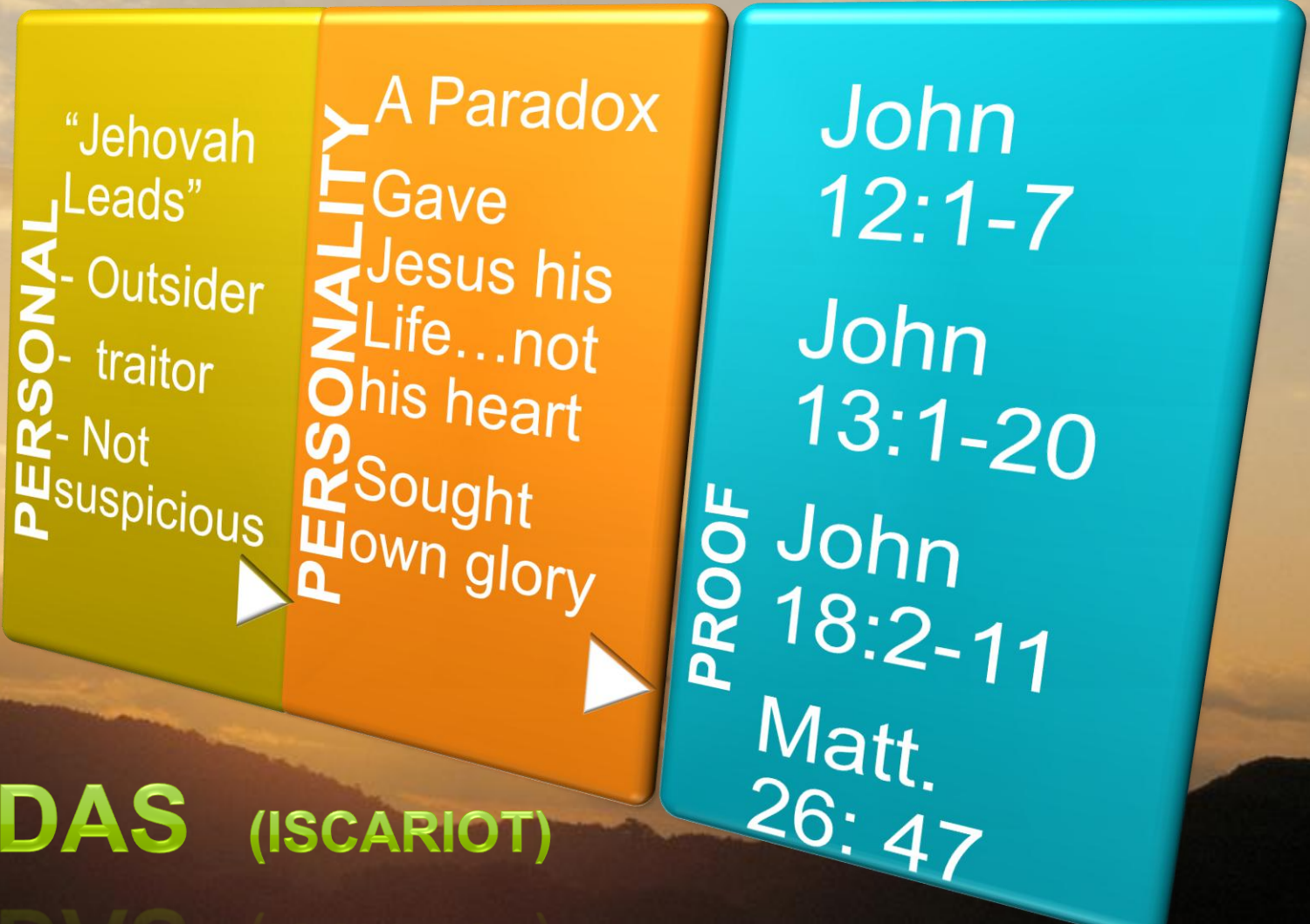
A Paradox
