#### What Is Anger?

Anger is the emotion that develops when something we value or desire is denied

Anger: What Does the Bible Say?

Anger is the word normally used in the Bible to refer to an emotion considered sinful

- The Baker Bible Dictionary

#### Anger: What Does the Bible say?

- O.T. is used mostly of God's wrath!
- N.T. is used mostly of man's sinfulness
- One time it is applied to Jesus and His response to the Pharisees

The Bible Warns Against Anger!

Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret— it leads only to evil.

My dear brothers, take note of this: everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,

- James 1:19-20

for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires.

- James 1:19-20

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.

Godly Character is Not Angry!

Love is patient, love is kind.

It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

- 1 Corinthians 13:4-5

It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.

- 1 Corinthians 13:4-5

I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

"You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.'

But I tell you that anyone who is angry with his brother will be subject to judgment.

## Godly Character Resolves Anger... Quickly!

"In your anger do not sin":
do not let the sun go down
while you are still angry,
and do not give the devil a foothold.

#### What Is Anger?

Anger is the emotion that develops when something we value or desire is denied

#### Why is Anger So Dangerous?

Because our desires and the things we value are usually sinful.

What causes fights and quarrels among you?

Don't they come from your desires that battle within you

The Lord saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time.

#### So, What About Anger?

- 1. It is best to avoid anger altogether
- 2. Judge anger by God's standards
- 3. Resolve anger immediately

#### So, What Did Jesus Do?

- 1. He was "specific" in conflict.
- 2. He was "biblical" in conflict.
- 3. He was "heart focused" in conflict.
