#### Tabernacles: An Decisive Moment

"Three times a year you are to celebrate a festival to me.

"Celebrate the Feast of Unleavened Bread;...

"Celebrate the Feast of Harvest with the firstfruits of the crops you sow in your field....



"Celebrate the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in your crops from the field.

"Three times a year all the men are to appear before the Sovereign Lord.



The Lord said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites: 'On the fifteenth day of the seventh month the Lord's Feast of Tabernacles begins, and it lasts for seven days.



'So beginning with the fifteenth day of the seventh month, after you have gathered the crops of the land, celebrate the festival to the Lord for seven days; the first day is a day of rest, and the eighth day also is a day of rest.



On the first day you are to take choice fruit from the trees, and palm fronds, leafy branches and poplars, and rejoice before the Lord your God for seven days....



Live in booths for seven days: All nativeborn Israelites are to live in booths so your descendants will know that I had the Israelites live in booths when I brought them out of Egypt. I am the Lord your God.'"

"Speak to the people of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall observe a day of solemn rest, a memorial proclaimed with blast of trumpets, a holy convocation.



... "Now on the tenth day of this seventh month is the Day of Atonement. It shall be for you a time of holy convocation, and you shall afflict yourselves and present a food offering to the Lord.



...On the fifteenth day of this seventh month and for seven days is the Feast of Tabernacles to the Lord.

Eat the tithe of your grain, new wine and oil, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks in the presence of the Lord your God at the place he will choose as a dwelling for his Name, so that you may learn to revere the Lord your God always.



But if that place is too distant and you have been blessed by the Lord your God and cannot carry your tithe...

then exchange your tithe for silver, and take the silver with you and go to the place the Lord your God will choose.



Use the silver to buy whatever you like: cattle, sheep, wine or other fermented drink, or anything you wish. Then you and your household shall eat there in the presence of the Lord your God and rejoice.

## BEGINNING ORD John 7:37-39

On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."

## BEGINNING ORD John 7:37-39

By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

### What Makes the "Water" Significant?



"With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation"

This verse was proclaimed – in the hope of the Messiah's return – at the feast ceremony on the second Sabbath.
