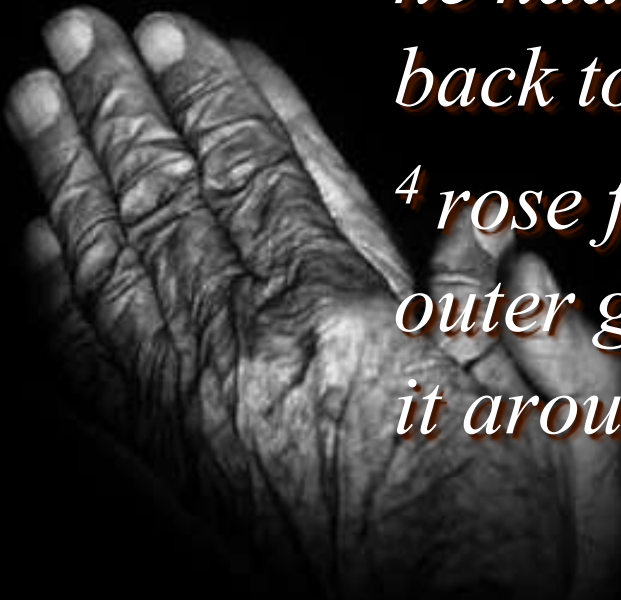


our Advocate:
