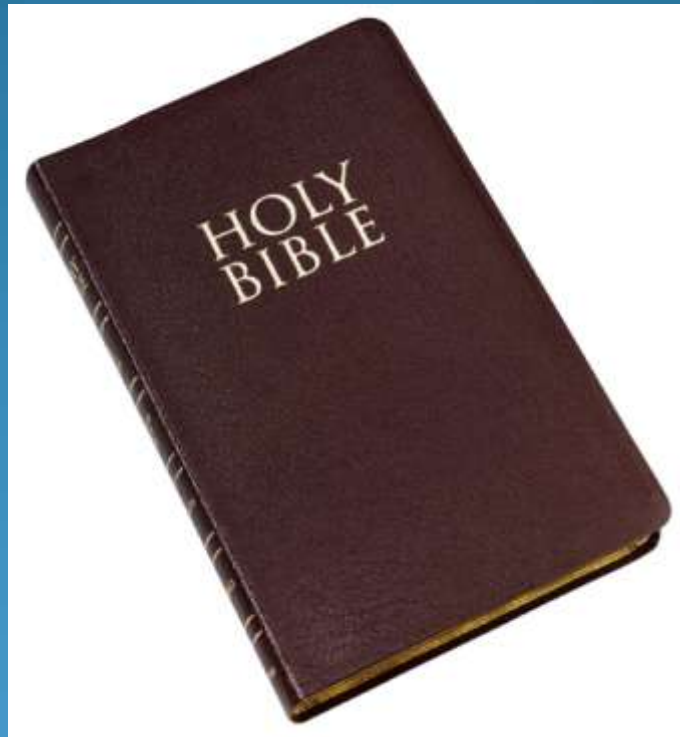

Powerful in Preservation

- “God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,

Hebrews 1:2

- has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds,

Hebrews 1:3

- Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Hebrews 1:4

- Having become so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.”

Thoughts about Christ

- “Heir of all things” -- at the *end*
- “Through whom also He made” – in the *beginning*
- “Upholding all things” – in the *present*, now
- **By The Word of His Power**

Thoughts about Christ

- **His Person** - “Spitting image” of the Father
- **His Work** -- He purged our sins
- **His Position** -- Made so much better than the angels

A Better Name: Son not servant

A Better Place: Sitting not serving

Thoughts about Christ

- The angels were involved with revealing the Law of Moses (Acts 7:53; Galatians 3:19; Hebrews 2:1-4)
- The revelation we now have in Christ is far better than the Law--inasmuch as Christ is far better than angels.
- The value of the message is linked to the value of the messenger who delivers it.
