What time is check-in open on Friday?

What do I need to bring?

Clothes and toiletries for the weekend. Your Bible and a notebook. Bed linens and towels are provided. The majority of our activities will be indoors, but there are some outdoor spaces and places to stroll. Bring jackets if you want to be outside.

Also, feel free to bring any individual craft items (knitting, cross-stitch, etc.) that you just never have time to do. There will be some free time on Saturday afternoon, maybe you can get some of your personal projects done, while chatting with friends.

What's the deal with driving and parking?

Unless you have a need to drive yourself, we encourage you to carpool, as parking space is a tad limited at our location. If your car is coming to the center, we will need to get your info for a parking pass.
